Purpose: Pima County Health Department (PCHD) and Pascua Yaqui Tribe (PYT) desire to collaborate to ensure adequate information sharing, resource management, public health training, joint disease investigation, media releases, and operation support during public health emergencies.

The Parties agree to amend Paragraph 8 "Effective Period" of the IGA, by inserting the words "and 6 months to October 21, 2026" at the end of the sentence.
