PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Pop Cycle was founded in 2008 by DeeDee Koenen and Shannon Riggs of DDCo Design and Jennifer Radler of Monster Booty Threads, who wanted to feature products made using up-cycled materials; and

WHEREAS, the name Pop Cycle comes from pop art from up-cycled materials and many of the featured makers offer handcrafted goods crafted from reclaimed materials such as magnets, coat racks, and serving trays; and

WHEREAS, Pop Cycle is approaching 18 years of operation, is currently featuring 110 local artists in the shop, and over its 18 years has featured over 600 local artists; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Pop Cycle helped found the Made In Tucson Market with the Historic Fourth Avenue Coalition to showcase local Tucson makers; and

WHEREAS, Pop Cycle employs many artists and makers themselves and actively participates in the Fourth Avenue District, weighing in on issues that affect small businesses; and

WHEREAS, Pop Cycle is very proud to be the first shop to carry many of its featured artists, including Marcy Ellis, Spring Winders of Heliotrope, Colleen Conlin of Crooked Tree Ceramics, and Josie Rios of Beads Over Diamonds; and

WHEREAS, Pop Cycle serves as a first brick-and-mortar shop for many artists and continues to grow and strengthen the community in and around Fourth Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of March 2026 to be:
