Proclamation for Fair Housing Month in Pima County

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (the Fair Housing Act) and the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 ensure full and fair access to housing opportunity; and

WHEREAS, April 2026 marks the 58th anniversary of the signing of the Fair Housing Act; and

WHEREAS, shelter is a basic human need and when shelter is denied, the quality of human life is greatly diminished; and

WHEREAS, people must not be denied equal access to and enjoyment of housing because of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, disability, or familial status; and

WHEREAS, despite recent federal efforts to defund fair housing education and enforcement and efforts to deny the Act's obligation to affirmatively further fair housing, the Fair Housing Act remains the law of the land; and

WHEREAS, Pima County recognizes and values the efforts of those who seek to reduce barriers to full and fair housing opportunity; and

WHEREAS, April is designated nationally as Fair Housing Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of April 2026 to be:

“FAIR HOUSING MONTH IN PIMA COUNTY”

and encourages all Pima County residents to work for tolerance and equal housing opportunity in our community.
