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To the Clerk of the Board,

Please include this formal statement in the record for the Board of Supervisors meeting on May 12, 2026, regarding the Pima County MS4 permit renewal.

As a Director of my HOA and a resident who has spent years tracking the mismanagement of our local waterways, I am writing to demand

a **permanent solution** to the debris and contamination in the Rollercoaster wash. We are tired of reactive, temporary fixes.

The County needs to address the following facts:

- **Failure of "Impractical" Excuses:** When we previously demanded grates to catch trash and debris, the County's exact words were that they were "impractical." We warned the County then that without them, the wash would become a dumping ground. We were right.
- **The Trash and Homeless Crisis:** The current state of the wash is a health and safety violation. The accumulation of trash and the establishment of homeless encampments within the drainage system are direct results of a lack of physical barriers and consistent enforcement.
- **The Navajo Wash Precedent:** The County is well aware of the issues at Navajo Wash. You cannot continue to claim these solutions are "impractical" while the community pays the price for your inaction.
- **Accountability:** Under the new MS4 permit, "maximum extent practicable" must include permanent physical solutions—like grates—to stop the flow of debris before it destroys property and pollutes our water.

I am submitting this via email because I cannot safely utilize the public transit system to attend in person. I expect these comments to be read and for the Board to stop ignoring the warnings of the citizens who actually live with these failures every day.
