CONTRACT AMENDMENT # 08

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background. On July 13, 2021, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide Legal Representation of the Pima County Sheriff's Department, Sheriff Chris Nanos, Sergeant Mosely, and Deputy Caudillo pertaining to the attempted arrest and shooting of Bradley Lewis.

1.2. Purpose. County requires continuing services and additional time is needed to complete those services.

2. Term. The County is exercising the fifth extension option to renew the contract for one additional year commencing on July 13, 2026, and terminating on July 12, 2027. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.

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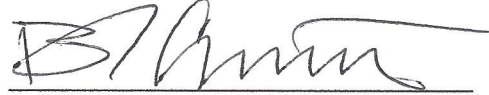
