**Purpose:** On February 7, 2006, City and County previously executed a 20-year intergovernmental agreement (IGA) to accomplish a mutually beneficial data network sharing arrangement between City and County. This new agreement will allow County and City to continue a mutually beneficial data network sharing arrangement. This IGA will be effective on the date it is fully executed by both parties and will continue for a period of 20 years. This is a zero dollar agreement.

**Intergovernmental Agreement  
between  
Pima County and City of Tucson  
for  
The Inter-Connection of Data Networks**

This Intergovernmental Agreement ("**IGA**") is entered into by and between Pima County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("**County**") and the City of Tucson, ("**City**") pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-952.

**1. Background.**

- 1.1. County and City may contract for services and enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-951, et seq.
- 1.2. City maintains and operates a data network (the "City Network") which serves the City's governmental facilities, as well as those of other public entities.
- 1.3. County maintains and operates a data network (the "County Network") which serves County governmental facilities, as well as those of other public entities.
- 1.4. City and County agree that it is in the best interests of both parties to share their data network resources.
- 1.5. On February 7, 2006, City and County previously executed a 20-year intergovernmental agreement ("Previous IGA"), CT-IT-13-682, to accomplish a mutually beneficial data network sharing arrangement between City and County.

**2. Purpose.** County and City want to continue a mutually beneficial data network sharing arrangement.

**2.1. City Responsibilities.** City will:

- 2.1.1. Continue to authorize County's permission to use existing interconnections under the Previous IGA between the parties' data networks, under the terms of those Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements by Amendment. Amendments executed under the previous IGA are being extended as **Exhibits B through O** to this IGA.
- 2.1.2. Execute Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements, on a case-by-case basis, to specifically authorize County's permission to use specific infrastructure described in the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement, which must be consistent with the terms and conditions of this IGA. If the infrastructure is leased by either party, then the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement shall be subject and subordinate to all terms of the lease. City's Chief Information Officer is authorized and directed to execute and terminate Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements on behalf of City without an amendment to this IGA, in the form of **Exhibit A** to this IGA.
- 2.1.3. Access to only such data, infrastructure, equipment, and systems for which County has given authorization as specified in an executed Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement.
- 2.1.4. Abide by the Regional Communications Networking Guidelines, as amended from time to time, and promptly share the latest version of the Guidelines with County.



- 2.1.5. Provide to County a base map indicating the current location of its network when requested by County on a protected confidential basis under A.R.S. §§ 39-126.01 and 40-360.30.
- 2.1.6. Be responsible for operational responsibility, problem determination and correction, and system maintenance for any equipment and infrastructure owned by City.
- 2.1.7. Not be responsible for loss or theft of any County information transmitted over City's network.
- 2.1.8. Not provide access to any third party, re-sell, or lease any network connections or services entered into as part of this or any Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement without the express written consent of County when County is the owner.

**2.2. County Responsibilities.** County will:

- 2.2.1. Continue to authorize City's permission to use existing interconnections under the Previous IGA between the parties' data networks, under the terms of those Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements by Amendment. Amendments executed under the previous IGA are being extended as **Exhibits B through O** to this IGA.
- 2.2.2. Execute Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements, on a case-by-case basis, to specifically authorize City's permission to use specific infrastructure described in the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement, which must be consistent with the terms and conditions of this IGA. If the infrastructure is leased by either party, then the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement shall be subject and subordinate to all terms of the lease. County's Chief Information Officer is authorized and directed to execute and terminate Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements on behalf of County without an amendment to this IGA, in the form of **Exhibit A** to this IGA.
- 2.2.3. Access to only such data, infrastructure, equipment, and systems for which City has given authorization as specified in an executed Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement.
- 2.2.4. Abide by the Regional Communications Networking Guidelines, as amended from time to time by City.
- 2.2.5. Provide to City a base map indicating the current location of its network when requested by City on a protected confidential basis under A.R.S. §§ 39-126.01 and 40-360.30.
- 2.2.6. Be responsible for operational responsibility, problem determination and correction, and system maintenance for any equipment and infrastructure owned by County.
- 2.2.7. Not be responsible for loss or theft of any City information transmitted over County's network.
- 2.2.8. Not provide access to any third party, re-sell, or lease any network connections or services entered into as part of this or any Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement without the express written consent of County when City is the owner.

- 3. **Payment.** Any agreement by a party to share or reimburse a portion of network upgrade or new construction costs for the other party shall be negotiated and included as part of a Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement. Payments for incremental services rendered will also be detailed in the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements. Parties will render payments within thirty days of a request for payment from the other party. There shall be no charges for operational costs. In the event of a dispute that cannot

be resolved by comparison and reconciliation of cost records or through other negotiations, the parties shall resort to non-binding arbitration prior to the institution of legal action.

4. **Term.** This IGA will be effective on the date it is fully executed by both parties and will continue for a period of 20 years unless it is, prior to the expiration of such period, extended or terminated by agreement of the parties.
5. **Termination:** At any time, City or County may give a written thirty-day notice to terminate any Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement and begin the Site-Specific termination process. Due to the nature of the services provided and the time that will be required to build or procure an alternative system by either party, City and County shall then agree on a future date on which the services delineated in the Site-specific Supplemental Agreement will be terminated, which shall normally be not later than eighteen months from the time the notice was received, unless City and County both agree to a longer period. During this period and until the actual termination date, parties shall continue to pay, if applicable, any monthly fees as set forth in the Site-Specific Supplemental Agreements. All fees are non-refundable except as otherwise expressly stated herein.
6. **Disposal of Property.** Upon the termination of this IGA, all property involved will revert back to the owner. Neither this IGA nor any Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement shall grant any legal or beneficial right, title or interest in any shared infrastructure to the user. Termination will not relieve any party from liabilities or costs already incurred under this IGA, nor affect any ownership of property pursuant to this IGA.
7. **Indemnification.** Each party (as Indemnitor) agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other party (as Indemnitee) from and against any and all claims, losses, liability, costs or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) (hereinafter collectively referred to as "claims") for bodily injury of any person (including death) or property damage, but only to the extent that such injury or damage is caused or alleged to be caused by a negligent or intentionally wrongful act or omission of the Indemnitor, or of any of its officers, officials, agents, employees, or volunteers.
8. **Insurance.** Each party will obtain and maintain at its own expense, during the entire term of this IGA the following type(s) and amounts of insurance:
  - 8.1. Commercial General Liability in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 combined single limit Bodily Injury and Property Damage.
  - 8.2. Commercial or Business automobile liability coverage for owned, non-owned and hired vehicles used in the performance of this IGA with limits in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 combined single limit or \$1,000,000.00 Bodily Injury, \$1,000,000.00 Property Damage.
  - 8.3. If required by law, workers' compensation coverage including employees' liability coverage.
  - 8.4. Each party will provide thirty (30) days written notice to the other party of cancellation, non-renewal or material change of coverage.
  - 8.5. The above requirement may be alternatively met through a self-insurance program under to A.R.S. §§ 11-261 and 11-981 (or if a school district, § 15-382) or participation in an insurance risk pool under A.R.S. § 11.952.01 (if a school district, § 15-382), at no less than the minimum coverage levels set forth in this Section.
9. **Compliance with Laws.** The parties will comply with all federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations, standards and legal Executive Orders, including laws governing technology and software. The laws and

regulations of the State of Arizona will govern the rights of the parties, the performance of this IGA and any disputes. Any action relating to this IGA will be brought in a court in Pima County.

10. **Non-Discrimination.** The parties will comply with all provisions and requirements of Arizona Executive Order 2009-09, which is hereby incorporated into this IGA, including flow-down of all provisions and requirements to any subcontractors. During the term of this IGA, the parties will not discriminate against any employee, client or any other individual in any way because of that person's age, race, creed, color, religion, sex, disability or national origin.
11. **ADA.** The parties will comply with all applicable provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336, 42 U.S.C. 12101-12213) and all applicable federal regulations under the Act, including 28 CFR Parts 35 and 36.
12. **Conflict of Interest.** This IGA is subject to cancellation for conflict of interest pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511, the pertinent provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.
13. **Non-Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other provision in this IGA, this IGA may be terminated if for any reason the Pima County Board of Supervisors or the Tucson City Council does not appropriate sufficient monies for the purpose of maintaining this IGA. In the event of such cancellation, the parties will have no further obligations under this IGA other than for payment for services rendered prior to cancellation.
14. **Worker's Compensation.** Each party will comply with the notice of A.R.S. § 23-1022 (E). For purposes of A.R.S. § 23-1022, irrespective of the operations protocol in place, each party is solely responsible for the payment of Worker's Compensation benefits for its employees.
15. **No Joint Venture.** It is not intended by this IGA to, and nothing contained in this IGA will be construed to, create any partnership, joint venture or employment relationship between the parties or create any employer-employee relationship between a party and the employees of the other party. Neither party will be liable for any debts, accounts, obligations or other liabilities whatsoever of the other, including (without limitation) the other party's obligation to withhold Social Security and income taxes for itself or any of its employees.
16. **No Third-Party Beneficiaries.** Nothing in this IGA is intended to create duties or obligations to or rights in third parties not parties to this IGA or affect the legal liability of either party to the IGA by imposing any standard of care with respect to the maintenance of public facilities different from the standard of care imposed by law.
17. **Notice.** Any notice required or permitted to be given under this IGA must be in writing and served by delivery or by certified mail upon the other party as follows (or at such other address as may be identified by a party in writing to the other party):

18. **Amendment.** This IGA may only be modified, amended, altered or changed by written agreement signed

by the parties.

19. **Severability.** If any provision of this IGA, or any application of a provision to the parties or any person or circumstance, is found by a court to be invalid, that invalidity will not affect other provisions or applications of this IGA that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.
20. **Legal Authority.** Neither party warrants to the other its legal authority to enter into this IGA. If a court, at the request of a third person, should declare that either party lacks authority to enter into this IGA, or any part of it, then the IGA, or parts of it affected by such order, will be null and void, and no recovery may be had by either party against the other for lack of performance or otherwise.
21. **Legal Jurisdiction.** Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as either limiting or expanding the legal jurisdiction of either City or County.
22. **Uncontrollable Force.** No Party shall be considered to be in default in the performance of its obligations hereunder or under a Site-Specific Supplemental Agreement when failure of performance shall be due to an Uncontrollable Force. The term "Uncontrollable Force" shall mean any cause beyond the control of the Party affected, including but not limited to, failure of or threat of failure of facilities, flood, radioactive contamination, earthquake, storm, volcanic eruption, geohydrologic subsidence, fire, lightning, epidemic, sabotage, subversion, change in applicable laws or regulations, restraint by court order, or public authority; and action or non-action by or inability to obtain the necessary authorizations or approvals -from any governmental agency or authority, which by exercise of due diligence it shall be unable to overcome. Nothing contained herein shall be construed so as to require a Party to settle any strike or labor dispute in which it may be involved.
23. **Entire Agreement.** This document, and any exhibits attached to it, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter addressed, and all prior or contemporaneous agreements and understandings, oral or written, are superseded and merged into this IGA. This IGA may not be modified, amended, altered or extended except through a written amendment signed by the parties.
24. **Counterparts.** This IGA may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together shall constitute one and the same IGA.
25. **Effective Date.** This IGA will become effective when all parties have signed it. The effective date of the IGA will be the date this IGA is signed by the last party (as indicated by the date associated with that party's signature).

**Terms and Conditions of use:** The parties agree to the following: The City will allow the County to place new conduit in the City Right of Way. The City will allow the County to place County owned fiber optic cable in County owned conduit and City owned conduit. To include the following requirements:

1. All 2 inch conduits in this route will require a pull rope with the County's fiber.
2. City is allowing the County to use one innerduct in each City owned 4 inch conduit along this route.
3. County will reserve 24 fibers for City of Tucson future use.
4. County will install tracer wire in any conduit that does not have it already.



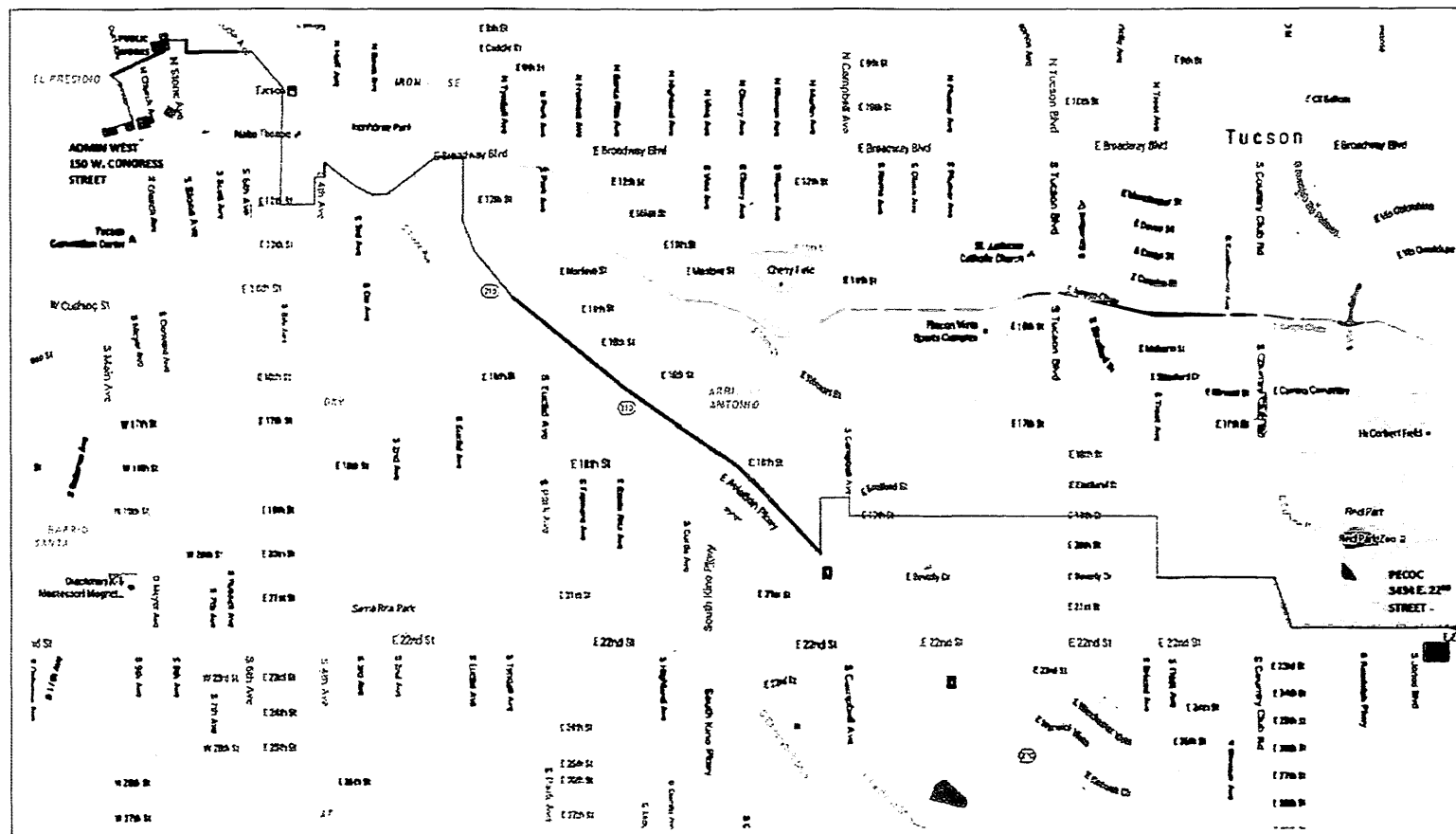

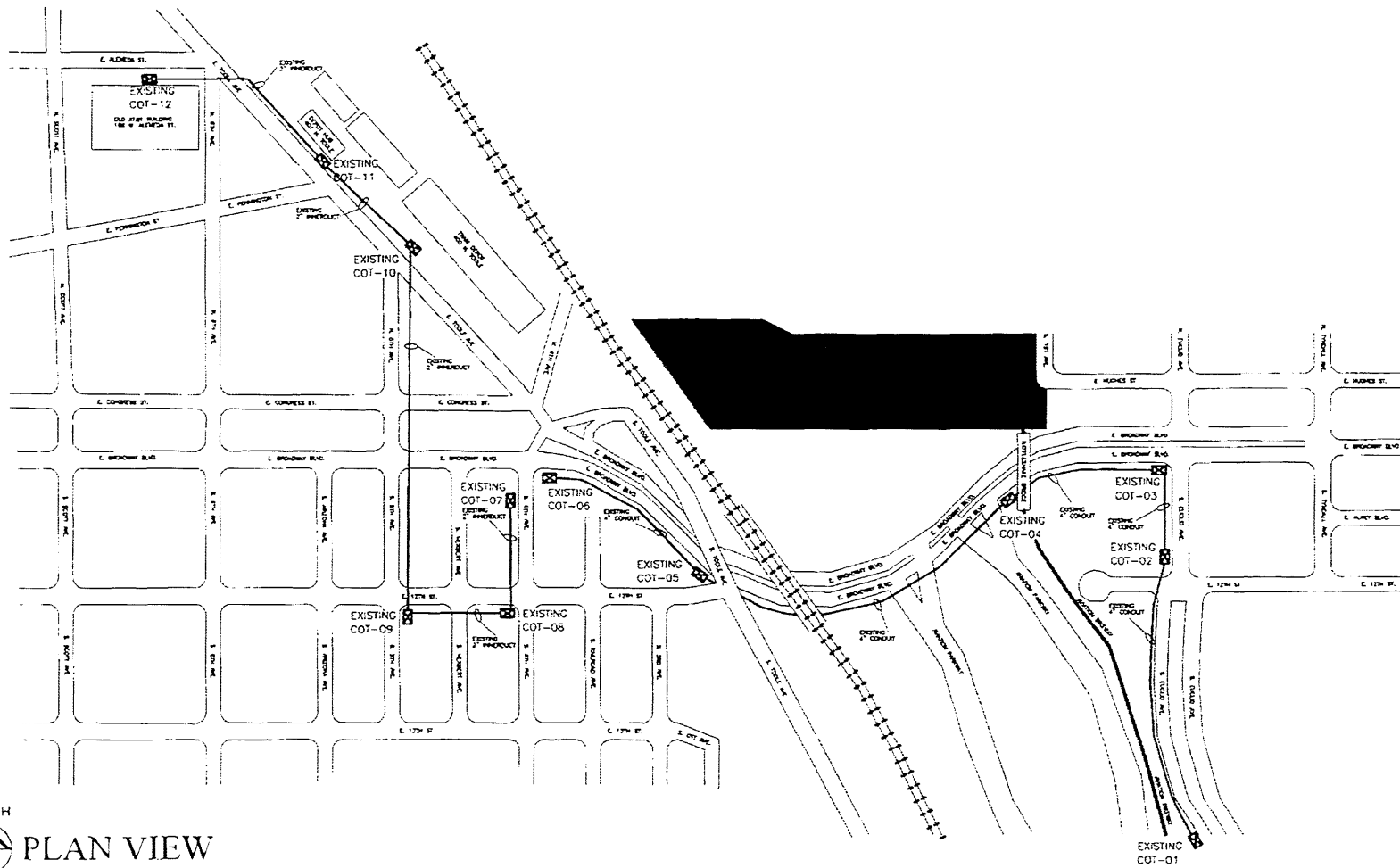
EXISTING PIMA COUNTY & CITY CONDUIT

2. City allows the County use of one 4" innerduct in each City owned conduit in this route.
3. County will reserve 24 fibers for COT use.
4. County will install tracer wire in all conduits.

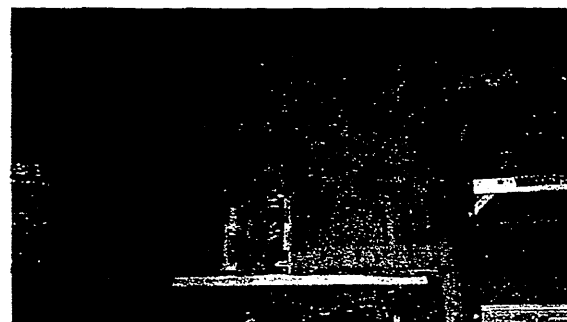

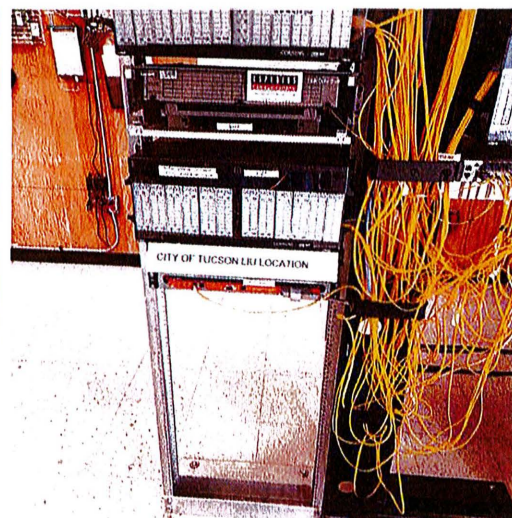
