Proclamation – 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF BRANDI FENTON MEMORIAL PARK

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Brandi Fenton Memorial Park opened to the public 20 years ago in December 2006, providing the community with a 55-acre recreational space north of the Rillito River; and

WHEREAS, the park honors the timeless memory of Brandi Fenton, whose life was tragically cut short at the age of 13 in March 2003, but who will always be remembered and loved by her family and friends for her beautiful smile and for being a friend to all; and

WHEREAS, Brandi Fenton Memorial Park features a commemorative brick garden, decorated with a metal sculpture of one of the butterflies Brandi loved along with other modern artwork, which serves as a quiet space for reflection; and

WHEREAS, the park features a wide array of community amenities, including playgrounds, a splash pad, soccer fields, basketball courts, an equestrian arena, an off-leash dog park, horseshoe pits, walking paths, and access to the popular Chuck Huckelberry Loop; and

WHEREAS, the park is also home to Sculpture Tucson's sculpture park, featuring a rotating gallery of contemporary artworks by talented artists for the public to enjoy, as well as several historic buildings from the Binghamton community; and

WHEREAS, the public is invited to join Pima County Parks & Recreation and the Fenton family for a family-friendly community celebration of the park on Sunday, April 26, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
