Agenda Item Report

Introduction / Background: Pima County repeatedly experiences thunderstorm-generated winds, dust storms, lightning, and dangerous flash flooding during the summer monsoon season, all of which pose a significant and ongoing threat to public safety and the community.

Discussion: Each year during the month of June, the Pima County Office of Emergency Management works closely with the National Weather Service and prepares a proclamation to be presented at the Board of Supervisors meeting announcing "Monsoon Safety Awareness Week" in Pima County

Conclusion: This year Monsoon Safety Awareness Week falls during the week of June 7 through June 13, 2026. Our office and other local partners such as the National Weather Service, Pima County Regional Flood Control District, Pima County Sheriff's Department, Pima County Department of Environmental Quality, Municipal and Tribal Partners, American Red Cross, and Tucson Electric Power as well as local media partners and volunteer organizations, will work together to promote flood safety awareness

Recommendation: It is recommended the Monsoon Safety Awareness Proclamation be approved for presentation on the June 9, 2026 Board of Supervisor agenda





PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service monitors severe weather and provides warnings to people within Pima County 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; and

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service works in close cooperation with the local media outlets to provide critical weather information as quickly as possible to protect lives and property from the hazards of severe weather; and

WHEREAS, due to its location and geography, Pima County frequently experiences thunderstorm-generated wind, dust, electrical storms and dangerous flash floods during the summer Monsoon, all of which pose a considerable threat to the community; and

WHEREAS, public safety during the Monsoon begins with teamwork between community partners and emergency responder agencies who unite to promote flood safety awareness and advance the life-saving message of "Respect the Storm: Ready. Set. Monsoon."; and

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service works in conjunction with the Pima County Office of Emergency Management, Pima County Regional Flood Control District, Pima County Sheriff's Department, Pima County Department of Environmental Quality, Municipal and Tribal jurisdictional partners, American Red Cross and utility partners as well as local media partners, volunteer organizations and other federal and state agencies to inform the community about what to do when severe weather strikes during the Monsoon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the week of June 7 through June 13, 2026, to be:

"MONSOON SAFETY AWARENESS WEEK"

and encourages all citizens to acquaint themselves with severe weather safety information and to use these life-saving recommendations to protect themselves and their families from the hazards that accompany the summer Monsoon.
