This Amendment extends the term of the Contract from 07/01/26 through 06/30/31 renews the Sierra Subscription and adds Sierra NCIP functionality; increases the Contract's not-to-exceed amount by \$2,100,000.00, resulting in a cumulative not-to-exceed amount of \$3,837,000.00; and incorporates the Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan provisions pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code § 11.40.030, as well as the Forced Labor and Ethnic Uyghurs provision pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-394.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT

1. Parties, Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background.

On July 1, 2021, Library District and Contractor entered into the above-mentioned agreement to provide Sierra Subscription & Hosted Services.

1.2. Purpose.

County is extending the contract to continue current services per Attachment 3: Renewal of Sierra Subscription (5 pages) and expanding the scope of work per Attachment 4: Sierra NCIP Implementation and Scope of Work (4 pages). The new NCIP functionality is vital for automating and enhancing Interlibrary Loan (ILL) services. Additionally, County is adding new terms as required by Arizona statute and County code, as well as terms to address additional terms encountered by County users online when using the services.

2. Term.

The parties agree to extend the contract term for five (5) years commencing on July 1, 2026 and terminating on June 30, 2031. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.

3. Scope of Services.

3.1. Sierra Subscription

The parties have agreed to renew the subscription services outlined in Attachment 3: Renewal of Sierra Subscription (5 pages).

3.2. Sierra NCIP

Contractor will implement the Sierra NCIP ILL Responder, as outlined in Attachment 4: Sierra NCIP Implementation and Scope of Work (4 pages). The new NCIP functionality is crucial for integrating enhanced features from our vendors, which will automate and improve ILL services for library patrons. ILL is a priority for libraries receiving Federal Library Services and Technology Act funding, as it supports resource sharing and access to information.

4. Maximum Payment Amount.

The maximum amount County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 5.2, is increased by \$2,100,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this Contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$3,837,000.00.

5. Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan.

Pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code 11.40.030, Contractor hereby warrants that if Contractor's employees perform work in an outdoor environment under this Contract, Contractor will keep on file a written Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan. At County's request, Contractor will provide a copy of this plan and documentation of heat safety and mitigation efforts implemented by Contractor to prevent heat-related illnesses and injuries in the workplace. Contractor will post a copy of the Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan where it is accessible to employees. Contractor will further ensure that each subcontractor who performs any work for Contractor under this Contract complies with this provision.

6. Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-394 if Contractor engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, Contractor certifies it is not currently using, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not use (1) the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; (2) any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; and (3) any contractors, subcontractors or suppliers that use the forced labor or any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China. If Contractor becomes aware during the term of the Contract that the Company is not in compliance with A.R.S. § 35-394, Contractor must notify the County within five business days and provide a written certification to County regarding compliance within one hundred eighty days.

7. Web Based Terms and Conditions.

If Contract is subject to any terms and conditions hosted on Contractor's website (collectively the "Contractor's Terms and Conditions"), the parties acknowledge and agree that the online hosting of Contractor's Terms and Conditions is for ease of administration only, and Contractor is hereby given notice that County cannot accept any revision or modification to the Contractor's Terms and Conditions without a signed written amendment executed by the Pima County Board of Supervisors or the Pima County Procurement Director. As such, the parties also acknowledge and agree that the Contract is subject to the Contractor's Terms and Conditions posted to Contractor's website as of the signature date of this Contract until so amended by the parties, and no terms in the Contractor's Terms and Conditions shall be used to nullify or void the terms found in this Contract. The terms set forth in this contract will govern usage by all users employed by Pima County.

8. Click-Through Terms and Conditions.

8.1. Click-Through Terms; Acquisition of Software.

If Contractor uses a web based ordering system, an electronic purchase order system, an electronic order acknowledgement, a form of an electronic acceptance, or any software based ordering system with respect to the Contract (each an "Electronic Ordering System"), the parties acknowledge and agree that an Electronic Ordering System is for ease of administration only, and Contractor is hereby given notice that the persons using Electronic Ordering Systems on behalf of County do not have any actual or apparent authority to create legally binding obligations between the parties. Accordingly, where an authorized County user is required to "click through" or otherwise accept or be made subject to any terms and conditions in using an Electronic Ordering System, any such terms and conditions are deemed void upon presentation.

8.2. Click-Through Terms; Usage of System.

If the process of accepting, installing, activating or otherwise initiating the usage of Contractor's products presents terms and conditions on screen ("click through terms") to the County employee

performing the action, the parties acknowledge and agree that these terms are informational only, and Contractor is hereby given notice that the persons performing initiation activities on behalf of County do not have any actual or apparent authority to create legally binding obligations between the parties. Accordingly, where an authorized County user is required to “click through” or otherwise accept or be made subject to any terms and conditions while initiating product usage, any such terms and conditions are deemed void upon presentation. The terms set forth in this contract will govern usage by all users employed by Pima County.
