Project Title / Description:	Cancellation of Fire, Water and Health District Elections

Agenda Item Report

Introduction / Background:	A.R.S. 16-410 allows that if the number of persons who file nomination petitions plus the number of persons who file write-in affidavits is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled for an applicable fire, water or health district under title 48, the Board of Supervisors may cancel the election and appoint the person or persons to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated.
Discussion:	The Board of Supervisors is being asked to cancel uncontested governing board elections for the November 3, 2026, General Election. Attached is a list of candidates who either filed nomination petitions or write-in affidavits and meet the requirements for appointment. A person who is appointed pursuant to A.R.S. 16-410 is fully vested with the powers and duties of the office as if elected to that office.
Conclusion:	If the Board cancels the uncontested elections, the districts listed in the attachment will not incur the expense of conducting an uncontested election. A candidate who has filed nomination petitions or a write-in affidavit for a position on the districts governing board will be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and will have the same powers and duties as if elected. If no nomination petitions or write-in affidavits have been filed, the position will be deemed vacant.
Recommendation:	The Elections Department recommends the cancellation of the uncontested fire, water and health district elections for the November 3, 2026, General Election.
Fiscal Impact:	The County will not incur the cost of conducting an uncontested election.
