
## Agenda Item Report



**WHEREAS**, for many years, many jurisdictions in the United States, including Arizona, have been celebrating the accomplishments of families who have overcome an array of challenges to reunify safely and successfully; and

**WHEREAS**, Governor Katie Hobbs has proclaimed June as Family Reunification Month; and

**WHEREAS**, Family Reunification Day in Pima County, on June 13, 2026, is an opportunity to recognize families who have successfully overcome the challenges that brought their children into out-of-home care.
